Conflict minerals

Conflict minerals are minerals that are mined and sold from countries that are plagued by civil wars, other armed conflicts or violations on human rights. This is especially a problem in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), but also in certain neighbouring countries of DRC, including Angola and South Sudan, there are problems. The most important conflict minerals are coltan/tantal, gold, tin and wolframite/tungsten.

The American rules regarding conflict minerals are included in The Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act from 2010 (the Dodd-Frank Act).

The rules charge listed American companies with reporting about the use of conflict minerals in their products. The obligation of reporting became effective on 31 May 2014. The rules are therefore not finding a use for Solar.

However, of commercial reasons, Solar will of course assist our customers regarding information about conflict minerals in products from our trading partners.

As Solar cannot sign general statements that all products in our assortment are meeting the rules about conflict minerals, but only can relate to concrete cases, we ask you kindly to inform which Solar products you wish us to investigate by sending us a product list.
